Bull Neck Swamp Research Forest is a 6,000+ acre tract of coastal wetland that is managed by the Fisheries and Wildlife Sciences Program at North Carolina State University. The tract consists of over 2,300 acres of preserves and 7 miles of undisturbed shoreline.

Management on the property includes extensive herpetofauna and mammal surveys, bobcat (*Lynx rufus*) habitat use and movement research, prescribed burning, and Atlantic White Cedar regeneration. Funding for research, management, and scholarships is generated through annual black bear and deer hunting leases and periodic timber sales.
